COF207: Ethiopian Natural Sidamo

Restrained blueberry, some citrus notes (grapefruit), with beautiful floral and peppery notes - med+ acid and med body. Complex and winey.

Cupping/Tasting Notes:

Very complex and delicious. In the aroma - citrus, blueberry and some apple with floral and black pepper notes. The flavor follows with more emphasis on the floral and citrus - though the blueberry flavor is still there. Finishes dry and a bit citrusy - like a good white wine almost!

Roasting Notes:

I'd go right to second crack, and maybe 10-15 seconds in to cut this guy off. It's a pretty bright coffee, so lighter roasts may be a bit much to handle. That said, we did a 66/33 blend of this a Brazilian that was also on the cupping table for a french press, and it was quite delicious at a light roast. (66% Brazilian, 33% Sidamo).
