COF249: Guatemalan Finca Bourbon, BF

Pleasantly fruity with a classic Guatemalan light smokiness. Juicy acidity, med. body, and a very clean aftertaste.

Cupping/Tasting Notes:

The aroma gives off a sweet fruitiness, just a tinge of blueberry. (Not like some Sidamos, but definitely there) The flavor adds a touch of smokiness, a light caramel, and the blueberry flavor carries through. The acidity is elegant and juicy - not harsh. The aftertaste, like most Central American coffees is very clean.

Roasting Notes:

I'd take this coffee lightly into second crack - the acidity does need some taming, but not too much. Lighter roasts will probably be a bit intense if you drink the bean by itself.
